

In the 90s, God led my dad, Jerry

McNally, along with Elias, a local pastor,

and a group through the mountains of

Oaxaca's Mixteca region. They had

been walking all night through rain and

hail, and even Elias, a man used to the

mountains, was ready to stop and rest.

But they pressed on a little farther—and

just ten minutes later, they arrived at

the doorstep of a man named Nemesio.

That night, Nemesio asked them to

share the Gospel with his neighbors,

seven kilometers away. God healed

the neighbor's mother-in-law, and the

entire family came to Christ. From that

Nemesio had a deep desire to see the church continue to grow, encouraged by my dad during his last months on earth. Today, his legacy lives on: his son, Eliel, recently sent his oldest daughter to Nations Ministry Institute, a training program of Living Hope. She is preparing to return and bless the very church her grandfather helped establish, continuing the work that began decades ago.

Stories like Nemesio's and Heidi's remind us why we keep pressing on—to spread the Gospel, equip the next generation, and walk alongside churches across Oaxaca. God is faithful to establish His kingdom, and we are grateful to be a part of what He is doing.

# This is my story: Cris

CRIS'S JOURNEY: FROM STRUGGLE TO HOPE IN GOD'S PURSUIT

"God has pursued me, shaped me, and given me hope. Today, I can say with confidence that I will leave Esperanza Viva with a future." —Cris, 15

ere I am, sitting outside right after lunch. It's quiet; no one else is around. I take a deep breath, and peace settles over me—not just around me, but over this whole place. As I exhale, I know deep down I am here not by chance, and not even because I wanted to be (at least not at first), but because God relentlessly pursued me.

He allowed challenges in my life from an early age. At just seven years old, I was worrying about and caring for my mom while she went through chemo. No child should have to see what I saw at that age.

But even then, God was pursuing me. He cared for me deeply, never letting me out of His reach. I think I felt His presence even before I understood what it really was—until coming here.

That's how God gets our attention many times. He allows the impossible, the unimaginable, so that we have no choice but to reach for Him to carry us through.

When my mom recovered, life didn't suddenly get easy. My parents divorced, and we struggled in poverty, just me and my mom. By the time I was 11, I was already working more than full-time and earning about \$10 USD a week. But I didn't mind—I believed it was worth it.

At the time my mom suggested going to Esperanza Viva, so that I could learn to read and write and be a kid, I was so overwhelmed that I ran away. I didn't know what I wanted—but I felt a heavy weight on me. I knew I needed a better place to grow and learn, without needing to worry about working just to survive. Eventually, I asked God—even though I didn't yet have a personal relationship with Him—what He wanted for my life. And He answered clearly: Esperanza Viva.

Through my three years here at Esperanza Viva and attending Nations Church, my relationship with God has grown. It's become real, steady, and constant. Because to truly know our Creator, we have to pursue Him daily—just as He pursues us.

God has changed me. He has pursued me, shaped me, and given me hope. Today, I can say with confidence that I will leave Esperanza Viva one day with a future. I will graduate. I will study. And I will serve God, sharing with others how He has transformed my life.

My prayer is that others will experience the same pursuit of God's love that forever changed my heart."
