General Climate: The climate of Puebla is moderated by its high altitude of 7,200 ft. As a result, it rarely gets truly hot, with temperatures seldom warmer than 80°F. Year-round daily high temperatures are in the 70's. Night temperatures are cool at all times of the year, often requiring additional clothing. Puebla experiences a dry season from November-April and a rainy season from May-October in which heavy rains are isolated but come almost daily-typically in the afternoon and evening hours.
